LOVED WITH AN EVERLASTING LOVE

Jeremiah 31:3 says "The Lord appeared to me (Israel) from ages past, saying, "I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you and continued My faithfulness to you."

If we search for any reason for God's promise of restoration in the people of Judah themselves, we'll be disappointed.
